NEW: High School Mission Trip

Spend a week serving others and growing as a leader! High School Mission Camp is a new camp experience that takes camp on the road. Participants will meet at the CCC and then travel together to Minneapolis, Minnesota for a week of mission work, faith formation, and fun. This camp is open to all youth grades 9-12 who want to make a difference. Final work projects are still be determined. No previous camping experience is required but youth who have never attended a CCC event will need to be recommended for the trip by their pastor or youth leader. Cost \$320 per person

You never have to grow out of coming to camp! Senior Adult Retreat (Ages 55+) is intended to be time away at camp for older adults. Senior adults spend time in fellowship, study, prayer and worship. Evenings are spent around the campfire, telling stories, eating ice cream, and making new friends. Family Camp



Family Camp (ages 0-18 accompanied by an adult family member) is designed to be a weekend of rest, relaxation, play and God time for today's busy families. Begin the summer break with a weekend away together! How often do you have time to take a walk in the woods or play in the pool or lake with your kids or grandkids? You'll be able to get a break from your packed schedules and take time apart just to be together. Families will have a mix of free time and organized worship, games and Bible lessons with the large group. Family Camp is open to all children and youth ages 0-18 who are accompanied by an adult. Immediate and extended families are welcome. Cabin/bunkhouse (included) and private lodge room (\$85 extra) accommodations are both available for Family Camp. Cost \$80 per person, \$300 family max (3 and under free!)

Grand Camp

Grand Camp (ages 4 - Grade 2 accompanied by a grandparent) is a two day/ one night camp for grandparents and grandkids to experience together. You'll start the day with swimming, explore our camp through crafts and Bible lessons, have a cook out and s'mores, and end the day with campfire worship. Along the way you'll have some free time to just be family. We try to cram a whole week of fun into this short camp! In just 2 days together on Holy Ground you will make memories that will last a lifetime. Cabin/bunkhouse (included) and private lodge room accommodations (\$85 extra) are both available for Grand Camp. Cost \$65 per person

Beginner Camp

Beginner Camp (Grades 2-3) is a 3 day, 2 night introductory experience in Christian Camping for boys and girls who have completed the second or third grades. For many, this is the first time they have slept away from home without family members or been to an event at the Christian Conference Center. Experienced summer camp counselors act as "cabin parents" during the camp to try to make everyone feel welcome and at home. This camp is a fast paced, highenergy, fun-filled few days. We try to pack an entire week of camp into 3 days! Beginner campers spend time swimming, singing, playing games together, exploring our beautiful Holy Ground through their daily Bible Walks, and cooking s'mores around the campfire. Beginner Campers will begin to explore their faith (and make it their own!) in a safe and supportive environment. Cost \$150

Junior Camp (Grades 3-5) is a weeklong summer camp for elementary age children. Starting in 3rd grade, you can attend this amazing camp that is held in our new cabins. Adventure Camp

Adventure Camp: Iowa (Grades 6-12) is a different adventure every day. Our activities will include: boating on Lake Red Rock, a hiking/scavenger hunt day, a challenge day that will stretch your body and mind, and more. Campers will experience God through nature and through working together. This camp has a cap of 30 youth so get your registrations in early! Cost \$350

(NEW) Adventure Camp: Colorado (Ages 17-22) includes the basics of our local Adventure Camp but takes them to new heights... in Colorado! You'll challenge yourself in new ways with high adventure/ropes activities, a summit hike, and more. Limited to 18 participants, so register now! Cost \$400



At both sessions, you will accomplish things that you never thought possible! Experienced and trained adults will lead each adventure session. Off-site activities will be communicated in advance with parents/quardians. Youth are divided into age/gender subgroups for sleeping and some activities. ADAM Camp



The youth who attend **A.D.A.M. Camp (Grades 6-12)** enjoy a week of learning and perfecting different art forms. On the last day of camp, a final performance and art show is planned and parents and other loved ones are encouraged to attend. Youth are divided by age groups for sleeping and some activities. This camp has a cap of 30 youth so get your registrations in early! Cost \$350
