

Health Precautions

Out of an abundance of care, and in consultation with the head epidemiologist from University of Nebraska Medicine, the following protocol will be followed during Ministers Institute 2022 for those attending in person at the Christian Conference Center. These precautions are not only in the prevention of the spread of COVID-19 but also of colds and flus.

- Vaccines - we will require proof of full vaccination or a negative COVID-19 test 72 hours prior to attending Ministers' Institute. Full vaccination is having 2 doses of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine two weeks prior to Ministers' Institute or 1 dose of the Johnson & Johnson two weeks prior to Ministers' Institute. Booster doses and flu shots are strongly encouraged but not required.
- Face Masks will be required of all participants. The only exceptions for taking them off are when one is eating or sleeping. Each participant is asked to bring a clean mask for each day of Ministers' Institute, or disposable ones will be provided.
- Hand sanitization - Please use hand sanitizer or wash your hands often. Hand sanitizer will be located throughout the camp facilities for your use and you're welcome to bring your own to use. When moving meeting rooms and before entering the meal line, it is highly encouraged that all use hand sanitizer.
- Social Distancing - to the best of our abilities, we will try to be socially distant during workshops, worships, and at meal times. Please follow the guidance and furniture placement of CCC staff and the Ministers' Institute Planning Team.
- Water Fountains - The water fountains will not be available for use. The water bottle refill station will be operational. Please bring your own water bottle to help cut down on single use items.
- Air filtration - each cabin and the larger gathering areas at camp have filtration systems to help remove the large particles that spread germs. Please use them while people are in the areas.
- Singing - while vocal singing is one way we connect to God, it is best practices that we not sing in large groups, even if masked. Folks may hum along to the music but please no singing.
- If you test positive for COVID-19 within 10 days of attending Ministers' Institute, please contact regional staff so we can track any possible exposure. Identifying information will not be shared without permission.
